ORDINANCE 2018-289

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF HOUGHTON, MICHIGAN

THE CITY OF HOUGHTON ORDAINS:

- I. That Chapter 98, Division 8, Section 98-108 of the Houghton City Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 98-108. Principal uses permitted.

1. All principal uses and all uses subject to conditions permitted as regulated in any Residential District or the B-1 and B-2 Districts, except as may be modified in this article.
2. Establishments renting equipment, tools and household articles.
3. Automobile dealer showrooms.
4. Automobile car wash.
5. Wholesale uses, freezer plants and storage services, when enclosed.
6. Bottling works and food packaging.
7. Government uses including public utility offices, exchanges, transformer stations, pump stations and service yards, but not including outdoor storage.
8. Enclosed greenhouses, florists and plant materials.
9. Veterinary hospitals or clinics.
10. Technology, research, and light manufacturing facilities whose operations are wholly contained indoors and do not produce noise, dust, fumes, or other environmental or safety hazards.

This Ordinance was enacted by the City Council of the City of Houghton, Houghton County, Michigan on the __ day of _____, 2018. This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days from the date of adoption. Effective the ____ day of _____, 2018.
